Filing a Complaint with Pima County

Use one or more of the following methods to file a complaint with Pima County:

- Call **520-724-6410** to report potholes or other issues on county-maintained roads.
- To report an issue to Pima County online, <u>click here:</u> for potholes, graffiti, water leaks, trash dumping, abandoned vehicles, street light out, sign damage, overgrown vegetation, etc. NOTE: **SeeClickFix** is an app that you can download to your mobile phone from your app store for 'on the spot' reporting of the issues mentioned above.

- Online Form: Reporting a Complaint | Pima County, AZ. Web-based complaint form to report Pima County code violations. You may do so anonymously.

Call **520-724-7400** to speak with a **Complaint Coordinator** for assistance. Be prepared to provide the following information:

- Address of property where the problem has occurred or is occurring.
- Detailed directions to the location where you observed the problem. if it is difficult to find, be as specific as possible.
- Date and time the incident occurred and whether it is continuing at the time of your call.
- If you observed a person illegally dumping waste from a vehicle, give a description of the vehicle and the license number.
- The name of the property owner, if known.
- Description of the problem.
- The weather conditions during each occurrence.
- The location and extent of property damage, if any.
- Any other information that may relate the problem to a specific source or operation.

Pima County Sheriff's Office online reporting:

To report a non-emergency minor crime, such as speeding, theft, vandalism, etc, go to <u>Online Reporting: Pima County Sheriff's Department</u>. Then click *Submit a Non-Emergency Report*. You'll find a list of complaints you can choose from. For example, click on Traffic Complaints to report speeding. Include date(s), locations, and time.
